

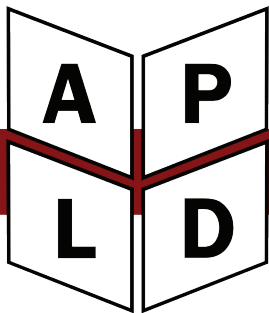

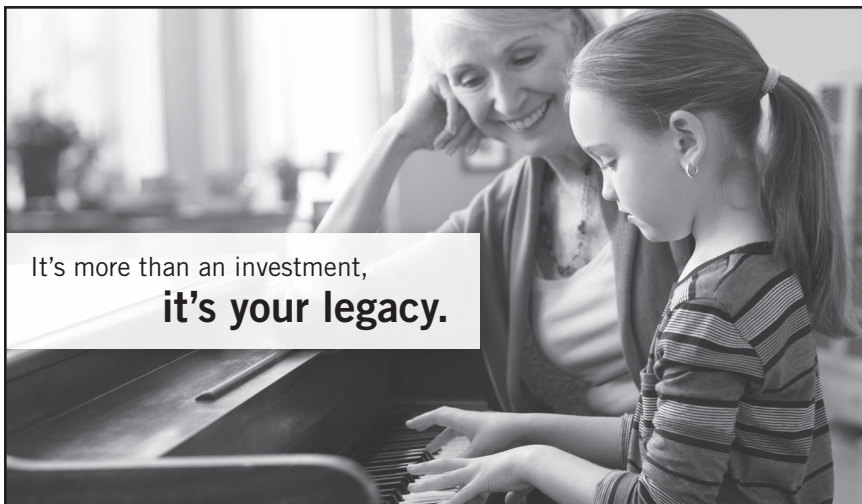

This is Tobias' 2nd show at PM&L. He is a little nervous to have speaking lines in front of an audience, but very excited to be in a show with his friend, Malcolm.



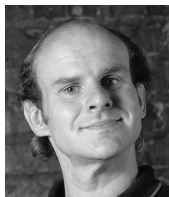
DANIELLE COE as Phoebe, Caroline.

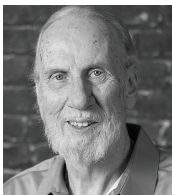
CAROLYN FLORCZYK as Charwoman, ensemble.

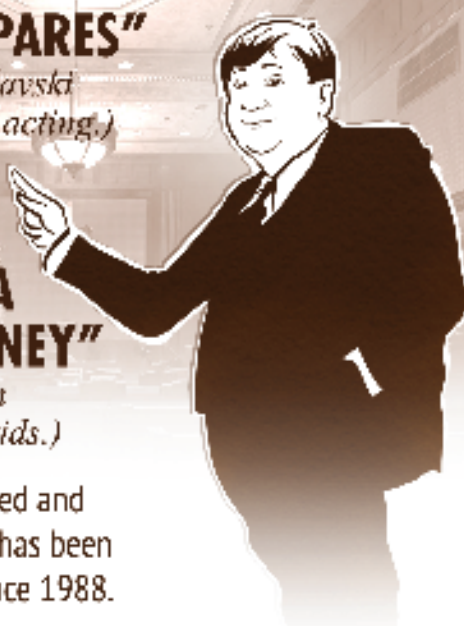
