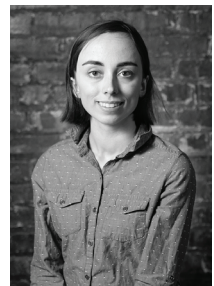
## Anthony Mannion as Tom Wingfield

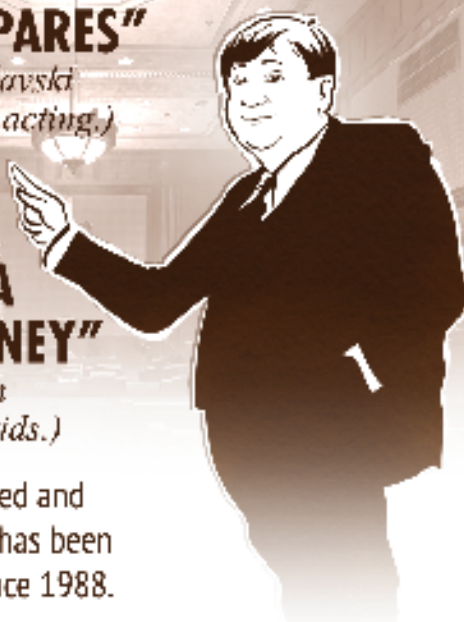
